Working for Landscape Protection and Appreciation

On Tuesday, May 24th, 2016, at 11:00 a.m., the conference hall at the National Pinacoteca of Cagliari, Citadel of Museums, piazza Arsenale, the museum's educational services, in collaboration with the Technical Institute Duca degli Abruzzi di Elmas, will inaugurate the "Working for Landscape Protection and Appreciation" exhibition. The project, promoted by the MiBACT board of general education and research, in collaboration with the Sardinian Museums Organization, worked alongside the high school classes of **third year section D**, who placed second in the contest of **Art. 9 of the Constitution "Active Citizenship to Overcome the Issues Found in Culture and Historical and Artistic Heritage"**, as well as **third year section B** students. This allowed for interdisciplinary topics where it was possible to deal with territorial and visual study while also delving into the details of Sardinian agrarian landscapes. The exhibition will display work done by the students as well as their planning for the restoration of Banzos, a rural area in Santu Lussurgiu (OR), where one of the agrarian institutes is located.
