Thursday, May 25th, 2017, at 11:00 a.m., in the halls of the National Archeological Museum "G. Asproni" of Nuoro, via Mannu 1, the Sardinian Museums Organization, in collaboration with the Tanca Manna Nuragic Experience 2017, presents *Ethnoarcheology: the traditional dying of fabrics*. The event falls under the calendar of events for the *Museums of Stories theme Plots and Sketches*.

It will be a unique occasion for students of all kinds and levels to experience in the dying of yarns and fabrics with natural substances and to understand the work and trade behind such an operation of yesteryear. In said demonstration, curated by *La Robbia*, an artisan laboratory that works with dying threads and fabrics with natural colorants, the work cycle method will be shown, with a completely artisan procedure implemented with the goal of bringing back those manual abilities that were once a Sardinian trade of quality and originality that stood out to the rest of the world.
