Weaving in Sardinia: Nule

National Archeological Museum "G. Asproni" – Nuoro

Saturday June 3rd, 2017 at 4:30 p.m.

Weaving on an upright loom. Old and new cross paths. On Saturday, June 3rd, 2017, at 4:30 p.m., in the National Archeological Museum "G. Asproni" of Nuoro, via Mannu 1, the Sardinian Museums Organization, in collaboration with artist Eugenia Pinna, presents *Weaving in Sardinia: Nule*.

Artist Eugenia Pinna, through her works, will illustrate traditional Sardinian weaving, in particular that of Nule, one of the few places which has conserved the use of the upright loom. After a brief introduction regarding Nule weaving, there will then be a practical demonstration on the use of the loom and the possibility to use these precious instruments. It will be a one-of-a-kind occasion for participants who will be able to further their knowledge of an artisan trade that holds a special place in Sardinian culture. Attendees will be able to experiment first-hand the weaving technique, with the understanding that certain traditions have gone untouched since the prehistoric era.

The event falls under the calendar of *Museums of Stories* and the theme of *Plots and Sketches*. Reservation is necessary.
