Up until Sunday, June 4th, 2017, the Sardinian Museums Organization opens the doors of the National Archeological and Ethnographic Museum “Giovanni Antonio Sanna”, via Roma 64, Sassari, to the exhibition created by the students of Artistic High School “F. Figari di Sassari”, *Discovering the Museum “G. A. Sanna”, treasure chest of cultural goods. Creative paths for a new art instruction.*

The works, created in the work-school alternating program – work, recreating ancient animals, vases, jewels, clothing and monuments that tell tales of, through different codes and languages, the history of ancient Sardinian populations. This educational experience by young artists concludes with the creation of more than twenty drawings and paintings that reinterpret, with varying techniques, the countless archeological findings present in the museum’s collection.
