

The Candeliere of the Massai. Devotion and tradition

The Descent of the Candeliere makes a stop at the museum. The ancient votive candle of the Massai is on display. Sunday August 6th at 7 p.m. in the halls of the National Archeological and Ethnographic Museum “Giovanni Antonio Sanna” of Sassari, Antonio Luiu, head of the museum and Bruno Lombardi, institutional delegate of the Gremio of the Massai, present the exhibition “*The Candeliere of the Massai. Devotion and tradition*”.

In the conference hall of the museum the Candeliere will be present for all to admire, which has an estimated inception date of around the middle of the 18th century, with its original iconographic dressing and ornaments formed by ears of wheat. The ritual of dressing it will be established in a different context, which is to the sound of a drum.
