

A future for military landscapes

**Arbuticci Fort - Giuseppe Garibaldi Memorial Museum – Island of Caprera –
Monday, August 14th, 2017 from 7:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.**

Arbuticci Fort: one of the highest examples of preservation, appreciation and conversion of a military structure in civil use. On Monday, August 14th, 2017 at 7 p.m. in the splendid Giuseppe Garibaldi Memorial Museum, which for the occasion will stay open until 10:30 p.m., the Sardinian Museums Organization invites tourists and visitors to participate in a night dedicated to “*A future for military landscapes*”.

The museum will open its display spaces for the exhibition “*Military Landscapes – Scenarios for the future of military heritage*”, organized in collaboration with the Department of civil and environmental engineering and architecture at the Università degli Studi of Cagliari, on the occasion of the 150th anniversary of the discharge of military strongholds in Italy. With the new display for the fortress, a piece of extraordinary beauty dating back to the late 1800s, on the inside of the walls which were primarily used for storage and packing of ammunition, *le riservette*, it will be possible to admire it all through description panels that display documents and proposals created by international experts participating in the convention that was held about this topic from June 21-24, 2017 in La Maddalena.
