To tell of the importance of wine today in our culture, the Sardinian Museums Organization, on Thursday, September 7th, 2017, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., in the halls of the National Archeological Museum of Cagliari, present the exhibition “***Wine in Sardinia: history that goes back 3,000 years***”.

Through a themed itinerary, visitors will experience the history of wine in Sardinia, from the Nuraghe age, which are the oldest known roots of wine, up to the Christian times, when wine become a central symbol of life.
