On Sunday, February 5th, 2017, the National Archeological and Ethnographic Museum “Giovanni Antonio Sanna” opens its doors to children and their families. Throughout the day, which falls on the first Sunday of the month and offers free entrance to all state-run museums, a series of initiatives dedicated to kids from 7 to 12 years old will be held.

At 10:30 a.m., a themed map will accompany visitors along a guided route through mysterious objects from the past, whilst exploring the museum and its collections. After the visit, kids will have a blast playing a team game about the findings from the museum.

The event that follows at 12:00 p.m. has in store a Sardinian dance show as put on by the girls from the Associazione Folklorica Thathari of Sassari, engaging all participants.

In the afternoon at 4:30 p.m., all kids are invited to the museum’s conference hall to partake in an entertaining theater production and a reading of “Giocagìò” as performed by Associazione Culturale S'Arza.
