

**Traditional tools: the Sardinian upright loom**

**Attempts at working with the loom that represent a timeless tradition.** On June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 5 p.m., the first Sunday of the month and hence free admission, in the conference hall at the National Archeological and Ethnographic Museum “Giovanni Antonio Sanna” of Sassari, via Roma, the Sardinian Museums Organization, in collaboration with Maura Bazzoni, Carla Galleri and Laura Mannoni, instructors in the course of textile production and tailoring at IPIA Sassari, associated office of IIS “N.Pellegrini”, present *Traditional tools: the Sardinian upright loom*.

In the hall where the works will be displayed, an instructional workshop will also be shown for kids and adults where the use of the traditional Sardinian loom can be used. Additionally, through a historic study on the instrument, with projection of the original images, there will be an analysis on the use of the upright loom over the years in Osilo, which the Ethnographic section of the museum has its hands on and will therefore be made available to the public for weaving technique experimentation.
