Concert by Santa Cecilia Polyphonic: A tribute to Robert Schumann lieder and novels

On Wednesday, June 21st, 2017 at 6 p.m., in the conference hall at the National Archeological and Ethnographic Museum “Giovanni Antonio Sanna” of Sassari, via Roma 64, the Sardinian Museums Organization celebrates the Festival of Music with a concert by Santa Cecilia Polyphonic, directed by Maestro Andrea Francesco Solinas, accompanied by pianist Matteo Taras, who will perform *a tribute to Robert Schumann lieder and novels*.

The Santa Cecilia Polyphonic, founded in Sassari in 1945 by Don Gino Porcheddu, is the longest-running choir in Sardinia, with a repertoire that spans from Renaissance polyphonic to grand symphonic-choral works, all the way to popular reinterpretations of modern and contemporary music and opera music.
