

**Book presentation “Manlio” by Giuseppe Garibaldi  
Garibaldi Compendium of Caprera - La Maddalena  
Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.**

**Garibaldi through history and literature.** On Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 6 p.m., the Sardinian Museums Organization, Giuseppe Zichi, president of the Institute for Risorgimento History in Sassari and Federica Falchi, professor at Cagliari University, present, in the splendid backdrop of the Garibaldi Compendium in Caprera, the novel “*Manlio*” by Giuseppe Garibaldi, edited by Paolo Sorba.

Untouched for over one hundred years, this manuscript, tied to the life and activity of the hero of the two worlds, was published during the marking of one hundred years since his death, in 1982. A book written for his son Manlio, it traces his childhood and the final years of being a general. The book is moving, it expresses a goodbye, a testament and an act of love that deserves a careful read, not just for style but also for the nautical vocabulary. Garibaldi writes until he no longer can. He doesn't believe in stopping, even as the pen trembles between his fingers. At the event, the author of the new edition will be present, Annita Garibaldi Jallet. The book has been recognized by the National Association of Garibaldi Veterans and Survivors.
