

**From memory to the theater – The fortress of women**

**Giuseppe Garibaldi National Memorial Museum – Island of Caprera, La Maddalena**

**Thursday, August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017, at 8:30 p.m.**

**The theater takes part in the Giuseppe Garibaldi memorial with heroic stories from myth, literature and history.**

On Thursday, August 24<sup>th</sup> at the Giuseppe Garibaldi National Memorial Museum of Caprera, the Sardinian Museums Organization, in collaboration with cultural association “l’Eccezione”, presents a night of originality, starting at 8:30 p.m., with the theatrical show **Women on the hem**. Based on some historical, mythological and literary figures, the piece questions the mysterious and fascinating world of women and their strong character in defending their own rights, affirming such rights in a society dominated by men, as they chose the path of betrayal, homicide or deceit.

Clytemnestra, Circe, Medea, Salomé, Madame Bovary: the heroines “of the others side”, victims and executioners who hold a place in our minds as timeless witnesses to unthinkable events. For the first time, the walls of Arbuticci Fort, with its extended opening until 10:30 p.m., become a theater stage, showing its versatility in welcoming Italian History and its hero, but also an original backdrop for stories of great women.
