

**Songs under the cross. Melodies around the symbol of the Christian martyr**

**National Archeological Museum Antiquarium Turritano**

**The remains of the Central Thermal Baths of Turrus Libisonis as a place dedicated to the memory and to the ‘*passio*’ of the Turritano Martyrs.** On Friday, October 27th, 2017 at 7:00 p.m., with extended opening until 8:30 p.m., the Sardinian Museums Organization, in collaboration with the polyphonic choir of Madrigalisti Turritani, is organizing at the National Archeological Museum Antiquarium Turritano of Porto Torres, a polyphonic concert by the name of: **“Songs under the cross. Melodies around the symbol of the Christian martyr”**.

In the week dedicated to the Festival of the Turritano Martyrs, which celebrates the traditions tied to the martyrdom of Saints Gavinus, Proto and Gianuario as well as to favor the raising in awareness of the tradition tied to the place of judgment for the “Barbarian King”, governor of Corsica and Sardinia, the public will be presented with the remains of the Central Thermal Baths linked to the memory of the Turritano Martyrs. The polyphonic chorus of Madrigalisti Turritani, out of respect for the tradition, will present an original repertoire, with songs selected and tied to the concert of the martyrs and the passion of Christ.
