

Arbuticci Fortress: from military building to place of culture

Garibaldi Memorial – Isle of Caprera, La Maddalena

Monday 20th November 2017, from 8.30 a.m.

The Arbuticci Fortress is one of the best examples of a military structure who has been preserved, enhanced and converted to civilian use. Within the impressive scenario of the Giuseppe Garibaldi Memorial, the Polo museale inaugurates a permanent exhibition called “*Arbuticci Fortress: from military building to place of culture*”.

A new setup has been realized inside the extraordinary beautiful *Batteria* Arbuticci. In the very rooms, called *riservette*, once used for the storing and assembling of ammunition, exhibition panels will display the documents containing the history of the Fortress since the end of 19th c., when it was built, until its transformation into a cultural site in 2012. In addition to texts in Italian and English, guests will find pictures and original documents allowing a comparison between places of the past and their new usage in the present.
